The EH Grade is the heart of Euler Hermes' knowledge and will help you identify and avoid risks as well as capture growth opportunities for each of your customers.

The EH Grade also forms the basis of the approved coverage assigned to each of your customers in your credit insurance policy. This coverage is frequently revised as we gain access to new information.

On what basis is the EH Grade assigned?

To obtain the EH buyer grade and predict the risk of default, Euler Hermes Risk Underwriters combine proprietary EH information with publicly available data.
